TASK 1. REVIEW REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFPs) FOR ANNUAL CONFERENCE VENUE

Tina Carstens opened the meeting at 1:00 p.m. Maddy Bohn provided an overview of the request for proposals. The RFPs were sent to eight venues. Of those that responded, two were suitable for our conference needs.

A survey will be developed and sent to last year's attendees and vendors to gauge interest in the possibility of changing locations and additional travel. Once the survey results are compiled and the tour is complete, a committee meeting will be scheduled.
